RE: Legal Opinion Regarding Coral Gables Library Advisory Board – Fundraising And Increase In Monthly Meetings

Date: February 5, 2014

Thank you for the inquiry. I did not realize these questions were still pending for a response. I'm sorry about that. In answer to your first question, the board cannot perform a fundraising function "without the express authority and subject to conditions as imposed by the city commission." City Code, Sec. 2-62(i). Accordingly, if the board wishes to fundraise in a specific manner, I would suggest raising your plan directly with the City Commission, or raising the issue with the staff liaison to see if staff would recommend the plan to the City Commission.

In answer to your second question, it is my understanding that the library Advisory Board is required to meet every other month or upon the call of the Chairperson or Secretary of the Library Advisory Board. The Chairperson or Secretary could therefore lawfully call meetings more frequently than every other month if there is a need. The additional meetings would then need to be properly noticed in accordance with the Sunshine Law. Written notice should also be provided to the City Clerk at least one week in advance of the meeting under section 2-65. I would counsel the Board to confer with staff, however, to ensure there is a meeting place and sufficient resources to conduct more frequent meetings.
