Public Works has been using a continuing contract that the City has with Metro-Express, Inc., for its Citywide sidewalk repair and replacement program. The Metro-Express Contract was awarded in 2013 to do various street improvements including sidewalks. As you may remember the sidewalk repair and replacement program was approved by the Commission and has been underway since late last year. I have taken the position that the Metro-Express contract can be used for this purpose, although I believe it was never intended to be used for such a large project. I would like to issue additional purchase orders to allow Public Works to finish the sidewalk project using only Metro-Express in order to finish the sidewalk project as scheduled by the end of August 2015.

Diana:

I spoke to Glenn about the sidewalk program. He did acknowledge that the original intent was to hire another contractor for this project. However, according to Glenn, sidewalk construction has gone so well with Metro-Express that Public Works decided to use them for the remainder of the project, which is slated to be completed at the end of August, 2015.

When Public Works discussed this project initially with the Commission last October, they mentioned in their agenda memo using Metro Express for this project, and that "they may procure the services of an additional contractor." At the February 24, 2015 Meeting, Public works provided an update to the Commission and noted in their agenda memo that Metro Express has multiple crews working on the project and that project goals were on target. Based on these 2 communications with the Commission, they have been made aware that only Metro Express is being used for this project.

In addition, as mentioned above the projected is scheduled for completion in August 2015, leaving very little time left for another contractor to work on this project after we bid out this job, and execute a contract. Optimistically, we could issue a Notice to Proceed in June, leaving potentially less than 3 months prior to the scheduled completion of the project. It may be wise to continue with the current approach of using one contractor, because of the limited time remaining on the construction schedule. When we first discussed this issue, I did not realize how far long they were on this project and their construction timetable.

Although I believe the contract was never meant for such a large project. I do believe the project can be done legally under the continuing contract with Metro-Express, but I will ask Craig his opinion on using this contract. Given the factors mentioned above and if the contract can be legally used, I would recommend allowing Public Works to continue to use Metro-Express and the issuance of a new PO to pay Metro-Express for their services on the sidewalk project.
