In these circumstances, the continuance must be granted automatically as a postponement, as there are only four Board members at the upcoming meeting. *See* Zoning Code, Sec. 2-203(B) (granting right for applicant to postponement when only four Board members are present). The applicant can be informed now, and the Board should be informed at the beginning of the meeting. The Board would not have any discretion to hear the matter in these circumstances. This opinion is issued under section 2-702 of the Zoning Code and section 2-201(e)(1) and (8) of the City Code.
